

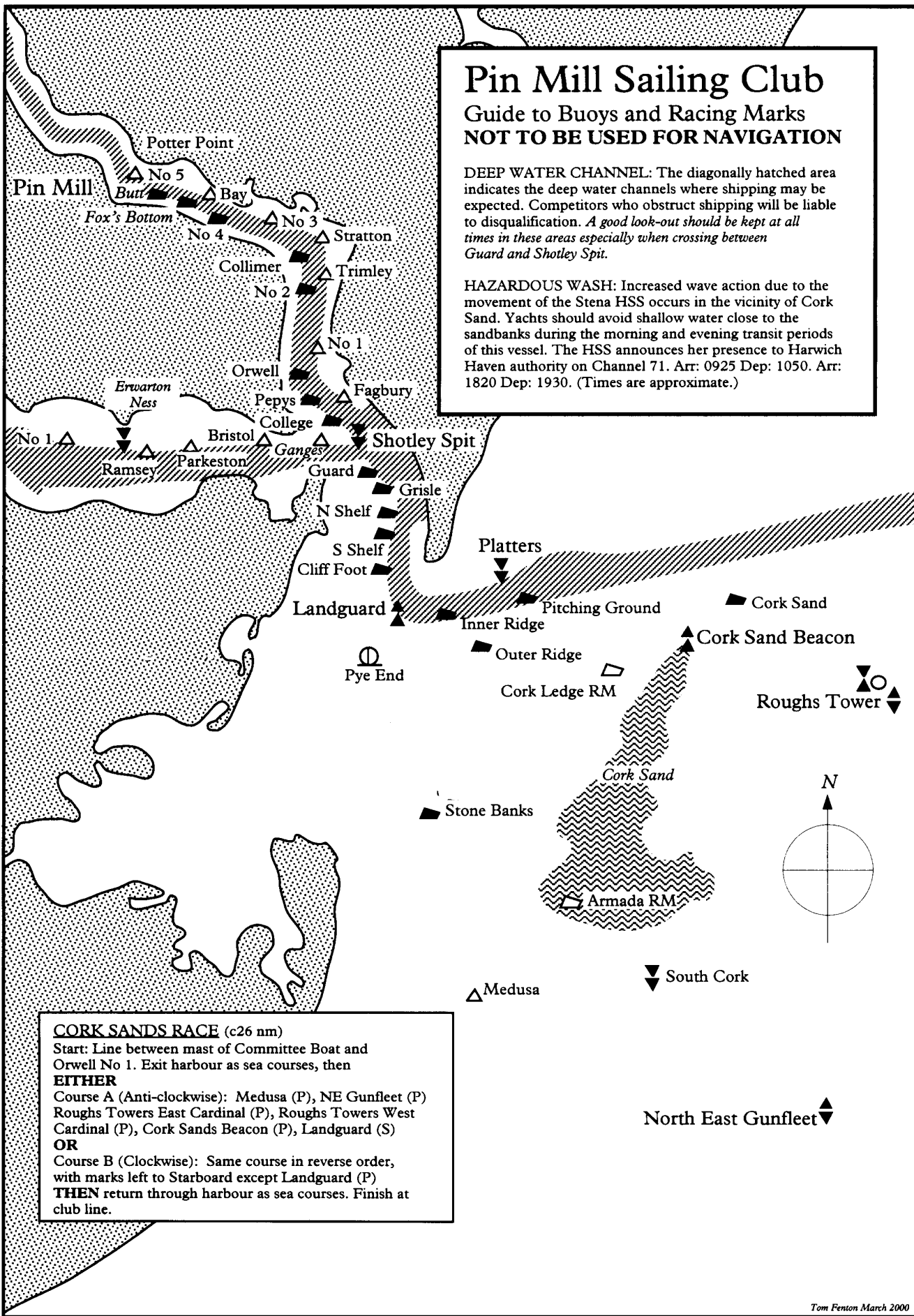

Guide to Buoys and Racing Marks

NOT TO BE USED FOR NAVIGATION

DEEP WATER CHANNEL: The diagonally hatched area indicates the deep water channels where shipping may be expected. Competitors who obstruct shipping will be liable to disqualification. *A good look-out should be kept at all times in these areas especially when crossing between Guard and Shotley Spit.*

HAZARDOUS WASH: Increased wave action due to the movement of the Stena HSS occurs in the vicinity of Cork Sand. Yachts should avoid shallow water close to the sandbanks during the morning and evening transit periods of this vessel. The HSS announces her presence to Harwich Haven authority on Channel 71. Arr: 0925 Dep: 1050. Arr: 1820 Dep: 1930. (Times are approximate.)



CORK SANDS RACE (c26 nm)
 Start: Line between mast of Committee Boat and Orwell No 1. Exit harbour as sea courses, then
EITHER
 Course A (Anti-clockwise): Medusa (P), NE Gunfleet (P) Roughts Towers East Cardinal (P), Roughts Towers West Cardinal (P), Cork Sands Beacon (P), Landguard (S)
OR
 Course B (Clockwise): Same course in reverse order, with marks left to Starboard except Landguard (P)
THEN return through harbour as sea courses. Finish at club line.
