Recording oceanographic equipment will be moored at :

52°12.60'N, 001°41.10'E

52°12.93'N, 001°38.28'E

There will be a Yellow Toroidal Shaped Guard Buoy at each site carrying radar reflectors. (Fig 1). A Waverider Buoy (Fig:2), at one site and a Seabed Lander (Fig 4) at the other site. Each buoy will display a flashing light of 5 flashes in 5 seconds with a 15 second eclipse and a repeat rate of 20 seconds (Fig:1) Data is freely available via the WaveNet website www.cefas.co.uk/wavenet

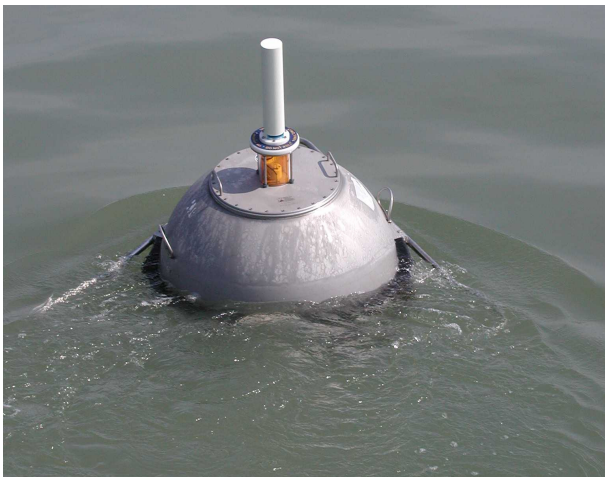


Figure 2: Waverider Buoy

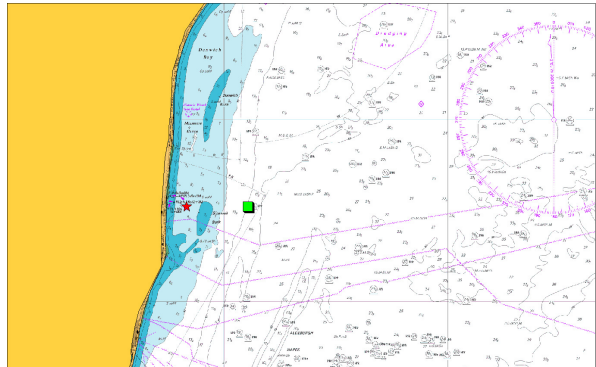


Figure 3: Buoy Location off Sizewell.
