Policy Statements

1. PMSC is committed to the principle of equality of opportunity and aims to ensure that all present and potential members are treated fairly and on an equal basis, irrespective of sex, age, disability, race, religion or belief, sexual orientation, pregnancy and maternity, marriage and civil partnership, gender reassignment or social status.
2. PMSC is committed to safeguarding, from physical, sexual or emotional harm, neglect or bullying, children taking part in its activities. We recognise that the safety, welfare and needs of the child are paramount and that all children, irrespective of age, disability, race, religion or belief, sex, sexual or gender identity or social status, have a right to protection from discrimination and abuse.
3. Children will not normally be admitted to the clubhouse or be allowed to join activities without being accompanied by a parent/guardian. Exceptions may be made on a case by case basis, if the parent/guardian gives permission.
4. Data provided by members will be used to process their membership and for their safety if using a club canoe/dinghy. It will not be passed to third parties. PMSC has a data processing policy, which can be found on the website.
